



## Green tech award at Working Buildings Week

EnOcean's wireless, batteryless switch technology won the "Best innovation in green product or service" award in The Working Buildings Week Innovation Awards 2007 – its second major design award in as many months.

According to Vincent Brain, event manager, Working Buildings Week, "There is increasing pressure on organisations to ensure that their working buildings are as sustainable as possible. We see EnOcean switching technology as providing a practical and low maintenance control solution for energy management technologies.
