In 2006, SAFE ID was able to successfully install its passport solutions in over 10 additional countries. The enlargement and diversification of the product portfolio, which combines manual and automated inkjet personalization systems with perso management software solutions as well as capturing and verification equipment, led to a stronger footprint of SAFE ID in various passport projects worldwide. Only 2 months after market introduction, the AS 1000 has been successfully sold in several projects. SAFE ID's *PerSoSuite Software* has been deployed in some countries for the first time to manage, secure and optimize the personalization process. On the manual side, the MS 200 has been released as a fast personalization system alternative with a multitude of security options. The brand new high-speed MS 300 will be officially released in the beginning of 2007.

In July, CCR Logistic Systems AG has acquired a 5% interest in the company with the aim of transferring SAFE ID's security software solutions into other relevant market segments, mainly on the automotive end. In August, Mr. Otto Schily, former Minister of the Interior of Germany, joined the SAFE ID supervisory board as a new member and in September, Mr. Dietmar Breyer, joined the company's executive board as President & COO. With these structural changes in place, SAFE ID Solutions AG feels confident to face an exciting and successful year 2007.
